DEGREE COURSE - 2023-24**

**PART - I**

**1. PREAMBLE**

Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University, Nagpur has been constituted under of Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University Act, 1998 (Maharashtra Act XVII).

**Executives of the University**

- i) Hon'ble Governor of Maharashtra State and Chancellor of Maharashtra Animal & Fishery Sciences University, Nagpur.
- ii) Hon'ble Minister of Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development and Fisheries, Maharashtra State and Pro-Chancellor of Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University, Nagpur.
- iii) Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University, Nagpur.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon University vide provision in Section 5 (Chapter II) of the MAFSU Act, 1998, admission to the post graduate degree programme in the faculty of Veterinary Science shall be held in accordance with the following regulations.

**2. COMPETENT AUTHORITY**

The Registrar, Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University, Nagpur shall be the Competent Authority for admissions. However, the Associate Deans of Nagpur Veterinary College, Nagpur, Mumbai Veterinary College, Mumbai, KNP College of Veterinary Science, Shirwal, College of Veterinary & Animal Sciences, Parbhani, College of Veterinary & Animal Sciences, Udgir and Post Graduate Institute of Veterinary Science, Akola shall be responsible officer for effecting the admissions. The decision of the Competent Authority shall be final.



### 3. DEFINITIONS

- i. **'Candidate'** means an applicant who desires to seek admission to first year M.V.Sc. Degree course in Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University, Nagpur.
- ii. **'Veterinary College'** means college to impart veterinary education in Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University, Nagpur.
- iii. **'Competent Authority'** means the authority empowered to invite the applications and effect admissions as per rules.
- iv. **'Intake Capacity'** means the number of sanctioned seats.
- v. **'Course'** means a unit of instructions or segment of subject matter as specified in course calendar to be covered in a semester. It has a specific number, title and credits.
- vi. **'Semester'** means a period consisting of minimum 110 instructional days excluding the period of examination.
- vii. **'Syllabus and Curriculum'** means the series of courses selected and designed to provide training to meet the prescribed requirements for a degree as specified by Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR).
- viii. **'Credit Hours'** means the weekly unit of work recognized for any particular course as per the course catalogue issued by the University. A lecture class of one hour per week shall be counted as one credit of theory, whereas a practical class of two hours duration or a working period of four hours duration in Clinical Veterinary Teaching Hospital per week shall count as one credit hour for practical.
- ix. **'Academic Year'** means a period consisting of minimum 220 instructional days i.e. two semesters of instructions excluding time spent for semester end examination and semester break.
- vi. **'Course of Study'** means M.V.Sc. degree course consisting of curriculum and syllabus spread over two complete academic years after successful completion of all credit hours provided in the syllabus as prescribed in regulations of Maharashtra Animal & Fishery Sciences University, Nagpur.
- vii. **'Constituent Colleges'** means the Veterinary Colleges at Nagpur/Akola/ Mumbai / Shirwal / Parbhani / Udgir.
- viii. **'Qualifying examination'** means B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree course or a degree equivalent thereto.
- ix. **'AIEEA-2023 Score'** means a total of the marks in specific group in ICAR entrance exam (Animal Science/Veterinary Science/ Animal Biotechnology) secured by the candidate in All India Entrance Examination for Admission in (AIEEA-2023) conducted by National Testing Agency, New Delhi.





#### 4. THE ELIGIBILITY / SELECTION CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

1) The candidate must possess minimum CGPA of **6.00** for unreserved category & **5.50** for reserved category in 10.00 point scale respectively at B.V.Sc & A.H. degree course or a degree equivalent thereto.

Conversion Formula for 4.00 to 10.00 points Scale:

$$Y = 1.5 + 2X \text{ for } X = 2 \text{ to } 3.49 \text{ and}$$

$$Y = 8.5 + 3(X-3.5) \text{ for } X = 3.5 \text{ to } 4.00$$

Where, Y = CGPA in 10.00 point scale.

X = CGPA in 4.00 point scale.

2) The admission of candidate to M.V.Sc. degree course shall be made on the basis of his / her merit in concerned group of subject in the All India Entrance Examination (AIEEA-2023) conducted by National Testing Agency, New Delhi. However candidate should be eligible to secure admission in any of the subject of concerned group.

#### 5. AVAILABILITY OF SEATS

Intake capacity, course duration, workload and eligibility for admission to M.V.Sc. degree course.

**Note :**

- i) **University Quota seats** - 50% seats of total intake capacity at each constituent college shall be filled in as State quota (S-quota) as per state merit list while remaining 50% of the seats of total intake capacity shall be filled as Region quota (R-quota) as per respective regional merit list prepared by the University.
- ii) **ICAR Quota seats** - Total 72 seats have been reserved as ICAR quota seats and shall be filled in by Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), New Delhi through an Entrance Test (AIEEA). The ICAR seats if remained vacant after ICAR admission will be filled in by regular candidates as per the state merit list in last round of admission. The subject wise and college wise distribution of seats are shown in **Annexure-II**.
- iii) **NRI/FN/PIO/OCI Quota seats** - Total 10 seats over and above the intake capacity of M.V.Sc. Degree Course are reserved for NRI/FN/PIO/OCI candidates (Please refer Sr. No. 9 on page 16 & 17 for details).

These seats if remained vacant, due to insufficient number of eligible candidates or any other reason, those will be filled in during special round of admission by candidates from the state merit list. The candidates from state merit list desirous to take admission on vacant seats under this category shall have to fill up an online option form during special round by paying Rs.5000/- through online payment gateway. If got admitted, the fees applicable to NRI/FN/PIO/OCI candidates (12,000 U.S. \$ per year in addition to the regular fee) will be charged to such candidates. Once the candidate secures admission under this category, he/she shall have to pay the fees alike NRI/FN/PIO/OCI candidate throughout his/her course of study. Special fee paid by the candidate shall not be refunded in any case.

- iv) **State Government In-service Quota seats** - Twelve seats over and above the intake capacity are reserved for In-service candidate of State Government of Maharashtra. They must secure minimum CGPA of **6.00** for unreserved category & **5.50** for reserved category in 10.00 point scale respectively at B.V.Sc & A.H. degree course or a degree equivalent thereto. The candidate shall have to apply online for the admission. The candidate will be admitted on the basis of list of eligible candidates communicated by the office of Commissioner, Department of Animal Husbandry, Pune to the University.



## 6. RESERVATION OF SEATS

All reservations are given on the basis of percentage notified by the Government for respective categories and policy of the Government declared from time to time.

### 6.1 Unreserved seats will be 40% of total intake capacity.

### 6.2 Reservation of Seats:

- 30% seats shall be reserved for female candidates from unreserved as well as reserved category.
- **Physically Handicapped** : 5% seats will be filled in from the total intake capacity as per their merit and as per the procedure laid down in GR dated: 11/07/2019
- **Orphaned Candidate** : 1% seats will be filled in from the total intake capacity as per GR dated:11/07/2019
- 2% seats shall be reserved for Special Backward Class (SBC) candidates and will be filled in during second round of admission at Step IV [See Page No.21 (xxiii)]



**NOTE :**

- i) Caste certificate and Caste/Tribe validity certificate issued by the Competent Authority shall be considered for benefit of reserved category.
- ii) With reference to the order given by Hon'ble Supreme Court Civil appeal No.11234-48/2017, candidates from SC, ST, VJ/DT(a), NT(b), NT(c), NT(d), OBC and SBC should provide Caste Validity Certificate. However, Candidates belonging to the categories of backward classes shall be required to submit the caste certificate and Caste/Tribe validity certificate (CVC) or proof of submission of proposal to competent authority for obtaining 'Caste Validity Certificate' along with the application form.

The candidates provisionally allotted the seats under reserved category shall be required to submit CVC **upto 24/01/2024** in admitted college, failing which their provisional admission shall automatically stand cancelled without any prior notice. Such candidate however, shall be considered under unreserved category for admission during second rounds onward provided he/she fulfills the eligibility criteria.

The candidates belonging to reserved category who has not submitted CVC along with application form and not allotted the seats during 1<sup>st</sup> round, shall have to **submit CVC on or before 24/01/2024** on email [admissioncvc@gmail.com](mailto:admissioncvc@gmail.com) failing which, their candidature shall be considered under unreserved category provided he/she fulfills the eligibility criteria.

- iii) The candidate should claim the applicable reservations in the application form.
- iv) A candidate claiming benefit of reservation under the categories of VJ/DT(a), NT(b), NT(c), NT(d), OBC and SBC shall be required to enclose Valid Non-Creamy Layer Certificate in the name of parent or guardian (only if either parents are not alive) as specified in the Government Resolution No.CBC-10/2006/CR-15/MVK-5 dated 5<sup>th</sup> June, 2006, otherwise their candidature will be considered under Unreserved category, provided they fulfill the eligibility criteria for unreserved category and submits the grievance along with difference of application fees Rs. 300/- in addition to grievance fees. The in-service candidate belonging to above category should necessarily enclose NCL in his/her name only.
- v) Candidates belonging to 'Creamy Layer' amongst the Categories of VJ/DT(a), NT(b), NT(c), NT(d), OBC and SBC must note that the provision of reservation is NOT applicable to them.



- vi) The Non-Creamy Layer Certificate issued by the competent authority on or after 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2023 or valid upto the last date of submission of application form will be considered otherwise the claim of reservation shall be rejected.
- vii) The SBC candidates belonging to non-creamy layer will be admitted as per the provision made in GR.No.TEM-3397/12926/(9086) TE-1 dated 11-7-1997. The adjusted reservation of Special Backward Class (SBC) will be 2% of intake capacity and will be filled in during second round of admission at Step IV [See Page No.21 (xxiii)].

#### (A) Agriculturist Certificate (AG) :

Certificate of Agriculturist for the year 2022-23 issued by Tahsildar / Naib Tahsildar on or after 01/04/2023 stating that the applicant or his/her parents or paternal grandparents is/are owner holding agricultural land and whose main source of income is derived from personal cultivation of agricultural land will be considered.

The claim of AG reservation shall be rejected if the main source of income is derived from other source and not from personal cultivation of agricultural land. Proforma of this certificate is at **Annexure VIII** of the prospectus or prescribed format of Government of Maharashtra.



**(B) Freedom Fighter Certificate (FF) :**

A certificate of the freedom fighter of the applicant's parent / grandparent (paternal) issued under the signature of Hon'ble Prime Minister/ Chief Minister of Maharashtra State will be considered. If the certificate is issued in the name of parent (FF) OR grandparent (FF), the claim of reservation will be granted provided, the applicant has attached fresh affidavit of parent (FF) OR grandparent (FF) OR if freedom fighter is not alive then affidavit signed by Wife/Husband of FF will be considered on a stamp paper of Rs.100/- issued / purchased on or after 01/04/2023 stating the following points -

- (a) Applicant is son/daughter of Freedom Fighter (Parent) OR grandson / granddaughter of Freedom Fighter (grandparent).
- (b) Freedom Fighter has not used this concession for any relative here before.
- (c) Freedom Fighter shall not use the concession for any relative here after, if the benefit is availed at this time.

**(C) Project Affected Person Certificate (PAP) :**

The certificate of project affected person issued by District Re-settlement officer/ Rehabilitation officer in the prescribed format as per **Annexure IX** of the prospectus or prescribed format of Government of Maharashtra will be considered.

Claim of reservation under PAP category can be considered for son / daughter / brother / sister / grandson (paternal) / granddaughter (paternal) / nominated by project affected person. If the land of applicant / applicant's parent / applicant's grandparent has been acquired by the Government for MAFSU / SAU / Irrigation / Power / Defence project, the benefit shall be given to them for the purpose of education vide Government Resolution RPA-3995/C.N.-183/R-1 Mumbai, Dated 22<sup>nd</sup> May, 1996.

**The name of the beneficiary candidate must have been included in the Project Affected Persons Certificate issued by the competent authority.**





**(D) Defence Personnel Certificate (DP) :**

Claim of reservation shall be granted to the children (applicant) of Defence service personnel, Ex-defence service personnel including those permanently disabled or died in action.

Candidate should be a son/daughter/widow of the person who has been a member of the Armed Forces of India and who has put in at least 5 years active service and has been subject to Indian Army act, Indian Navy Act, Indian Air Force Act and also includes Ex-Serviceman who retired, from such service or permanently disabled or died in action. The condition of minimum active service of 5 years shall not be applicable to the service personnel who are permanently disabled or died in action.

The candidate shall be required to produce a certificate from the appropriate Authority of the Armed Forces in the rank of Commandant or equivalent or from District Sainik Welfare Office/Board certifying that the candidate fulfils the above conditions.

**6.4 Reservation for female candidates**

- i. 30% seats shall be reserved for female candidates as per G.R. No.MED-1300/CR-271/2000/EDN-1 Mumbai 5<sup>th</sup> June 2000. The seats so reserved shall be available for all the categories like Unreserved, SC, ST, VJ/DT(a), NT(b), NT(c), NT(d), OBC, EWS & SBC.
- ii. Female reservation shall be filled in separately for “R” and “S” quota.
- iii. If required number of female candidates are not available in a particular category these seats shall be offered to male candidates of that particular category during second round of admission as per the procedure given.



### 6.5 Reservation for Physically Handicapped candidates (PH) :

Physically Handicapped candidate shall be considered admission to M.V.Sc. degree course, if he / she do not suffers disabilities in physical fitness as listed below –

- a) Disability of total body including disability of chest / spine more than 50%.
- b) Disability of lower limb of more than 50%.
- c) Disability of upper limb.
- d) Visually handicapped candidates and those with hearing disability.
- e) Candidates with progressive diseases like myopathies etc.
- f) Disabilities which otherwise would interfere in the performance of the duties of a Veterinarian.

The disability should be certified by Civil Surgeon / Medical Board and the candidate has to present him / herself before the Civil Surgeon / Medical Board. The last valid disability certificate of the candidate issued by Civil Surgeon / Medical Board should not be more than three months old from the date of submission of application form, failing which the claim of Physically Handicapped candidature shall be rejected. The candidate should submit the Physically Handicapped Certificate preferably as per proforma in **Annexure XI or prescribed format of Government of Maharashtra**. The type of disability and the percentage of disability should be readable / clearly legible to ascertain the eligibility for admission.

### 6.6 Reservation for Orphaned candidates (OC) :

One percent (1%) seats of the total intake capacity will be reserved for the orphan candidate. These seats shall be filled by competent authority as per Government Resolution, Women & Child Welfare Department, No.AMJ-2011/C.R. 212 Desk 3, dated 2 April 2018 and the policy of the Government declared from time to time.

### 6.7 Reservation for Economically Weaker Section Candidate (EWS) :

Ten percent (10%) seats of the total intake capacity will be reserved for the Economically Weaker Section Candidate as per Government Resolution Dtd. 11/07/2019. These seats shall be filled by competent authority as per the provision mentioned in the Government Resolution No. राआधो- 4019/ प्र.क्र.31/16-अ, Dtd. 12/02/2019 and क्र. राआधो ४०१९/प्र.क्र.३१/१६-अ, दिनांक-२३ डिसेंबर, २०२०. The candidate should submit the EWS certificate signed by competent authority as per proforma **strictly** given in **Annexure- XII**.

**Note: Claim under EWS category will not be accepted for candidate submitting Income and Asset Certificate.**



## 7. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

### A. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING FILLING AND SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM

- i) Candidate is required to download the soft copy of the prospectus available on website ([www.mafsu.ac.in](http://www.mafsu.ac.in)). The candidate should read the prospectus carefully before filling the online application form. The desirous candidate has to apply online for the purpose of admission.
- ii) Candidate is required to visit the website and click on M.V.Sc. degree course, log in as new user and he/she shall fill in the required details, pay the processing fees, upload scanned copies of all the required documents (preferably original documents), photograph, signature etc. and shall submit the details by clicking on the “**Submit**” link.
- iii) **Modes of Payment for Application Fees :**
  - 1) The application fees for **Unreserved** candidate is Rs.1000/- and for **Reserved** candidate is Rs.700/-.
  - 2) The candidate from the states other than Maharashtra & In-service candidate of State Govt. of Maharashtra shall have to pay Rs.1000/-.
  - 3) Candidate shall pay the requisite application fees through online mode.
  - 4) Fees once paid will not be refunded due to any reason.
- iv) If the application form is incomplete in any respect and/or if the desired documents are not uploaded till the due date specified by University for resubmission, it will ultimately lead to rejection of the application form or non-acceptance of claim of reservations and additional weightage.
- v) The candidates are advised to furnish accurate information in all the columns. The University shall not be responsible for any such discrepancy appearing in the application form which may result in deciding disadvantageous merit position of the applicant. Certificate /document issued by the Competent Authority will only be considered.
- vi) If any document/certificate is in language other than Marathi / Hindi / English, a translation in English duly certified by the competent / issuing authority should be uploaded.



- vii) If certain document/certificate to be attached is having more than one page (eg. NCL certificate, Affidavit, Research paper, Marksheets, Transcripts for more than one attempt, etc.) then it shall be uploaded together by converting them in one PDF or JPEG file.
- viii) For detail admission procedure please refer the application flow (**Annexure-XVIII**).
- ix) Candidates are advised to use desktop, laptop only with proper internet connection while filling the application form. **Further advised not to use mobile phones for filling the application form or at any stage of admission programme.**

#### **B. OTHER IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS**

- i) Candidates are required to ascertain their eligibility for admission before applying and to submit the required documents/certificates along with application form to make them eligible for selection process on merit basis, claim of additional weightage points and reservations.
- ii) The candidates, who have passed B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree course from any of the constituent college under Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University, Nagpur will be eligible for admission under R-Quota and S-Quota.
- iii) The candidates who have passed B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree course from the institutions situated out of Maharashtra and whose parents are domiciled in Maharashtra, will be eligible for admission under S-Quota on merit basis subject to the condition that they should upload the required Domicile/ Residence certificate in the name of candidate or his/her parent indicating minimum 3 years stay in preceding 10 years in Maharashtra state issued by Competent Authority from Maharashtra state.
- iv) The candidates, who have passed B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree course from any of the constituent college under Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University, Nagpur and admitted through ICAR quota under reserved category shall have to submit the caste certificate and Caste Validity Certificate issued by the Competent Authority from Maharashtra state for category benefit at the time of physical reporting/ verification of documents.
- v) The candidate domiciled of Other State shall not be considered for any category benefit.
- vi) The candidates should fully understand that the provisional admission to M.V.Sc. would be made on the basis of merit and availability of the seats.
- vii) No grievances / arguments of the candidates shall be entertained, if he / she fails to get the admission by his/her own negligence, late reporting, technical difficulties, personal problems etc.



## 8. LIST OF CERTIFICATES/DOCUMENTS TO BE UPLOADED DURING FILLING OF ONLINE APPLICATION FORM.

### A) LIST OF ESSENTIAL CERTIFICATES/DOCUMENTS

The candidates shall upload the following original/clearly legible self-attested documents while filling online application form. Before submission of application form, the candidates should ensure that the uploaded documents are complete and clearly visible. If any uploaded document is not clearly visible then reservation/ weightage/eligibility (whichever is applicable) shall not be given.

- (a) **Mark sheet/Grade card/Course Completion Certificate of qualifying examination.**
- (b) **Provisional Degree Certificate or Degree Certificate or Course Completion Certificate of the qualifying Exam.**
- (c) **AIEEA-2023 Score Card.**
- (d) **College (Last attended) Leaving Certificate/ Migration Certificate / Bonafide Certificate.**

If the candidate is presently admitted to any other college / institute after passing qualifying examination and applies for admission for the first year post graduate degree course, then the Bonafide Certificate of current year issued by the competent authority of respected college / institute will be considered.

However, if such candidate is admitted then he/she shall have to submit College Leaving Certificate within a period of 7 working days failing which his/her provisional admission shall be cancelled.

- (d) **Domicile Certificate/ Residence certificate** issued by the Competent Authority indicating minimum 3 years stay of the candidate or his/her parents in preceding 10 years in Maharashtra state or candidate's School leaving certificate (indicating the place of birth) or Birth certificate.
- (e) **HSSC Marksheet** is essential for tie breakers to decide merit position in case of similar C.G.P.A.



## B) LIST OF CERTIFICATES/DOCUMENTS FOR RESERVATION

- a) **Caste Certificate** in the prescribed format issued by the Competent Authority designated for the purpose in the Maharashtra State.
- b) **Caste Validity Certificate (CVC)** issued by the Competent Authority designated for the purpose in the State. The candidates shall be required to submit the caste certificate, caste/tribe validity certificate or proof of submission of proposal to competent authority for obtaining 'Caste Validity Certificate' along with the application form. However, such candidates who has submitted proof of submission of proposal for CVC shall necessarily required to submit 'Caste Validity Certificate' issued by the competent authority **on or before 24/01/2024** on email [admissioncvc@gmail.com](mailto:admissioncvc@gmail.com) as per the schedule of admission programme. The candidate failing to submit CVC even till the last date shall be considered under unreserved category provided he/she fulfills the minimum eligibility criteria for unreserved category candidate.
- c) **Non-Creamy Layer Certificate** for candidates seeking admission under VJ/DT(a), NT(b), NT(c), NT(d), OBC and SBC categories issued by the Competent Authority on or after 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2023 or valid upto the date of submission of application form.
- d) **Agriculturist Certificate** issued by the Tahsildar or Naib Tahsildar on or after 01/04/2023. Proforma of this certificate is at **Annexure VIII** of the Prospectus or prescribed format of Government of Maharashtra.
- e) **Project Affected Person Certificate** issued by the District Resettlement Officer/Rehabilitation Officer of Government of Maharashtra in the prescribed form. Proforma of this certificate is at **Annexure IX** of the Prospectus or prescribed format of Government of Maharashtra.
- f) **Freedom Fighter Certificate** of the applicant's parents issued under the signature of the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India/ Chief Minister of Maharashtra State along with required affidavit. (Please refer Clause No.6.3 (B) on Page No.8 of the Prospectus).
- g) **Defence Personnel Certificate** from Zilla Sainik Welfare Office/ Board / Discharge Certificate from Officer Commanding the Regiment or Serviceman Certificate from the competent authority clearly indicating period of defence service. (Please refer Clause No. 6.3 (D) on page No.9 of the Prospectus).
- h) **Games/Sports/ Sports / Debates / Essay Competition / Elocution Competition / Youth Festival / Cattle / Poultry - Judging Competition etc.** issued by the appropriate authority (District Sports Officer/ Deputy Director /Director of Student Welfare / Student Welfare Officer) stating that applicant has represented in inter-University tournament / competition should be enclosed. (Please refer Annexure VII). Proforma of this certificate is at **Annexure X** of the Prospectus.





- i) The candidates applying for admission under '**Physically Handicapped Category**' should submit the Certificate of Handicapped issued by the Competent Authority (District Civil Surgeon or equivalent Government Hospital/ Medical Board) designated in this behalf. (Please refer Clause No. 6.5 on page No. 10 of the prospectus). Proforma of this certificate is at **Annexure XI** of the prospectus or prescribed format of Govt of Maharashtra.
- j) **Orphaned Certificate** : The candidate willing to take admission from orphaned category are required to submit Orphaned certificate issued from Commissioner, Women and Child Development on his/her letter head with the signature of Deputy Commissioner (Child Development), Pune / Commissioner, Women and Child Development, Pune. (Please refer Clause No. 6.6 on page No.10 of the prospectus)
- k) **Economically Weaker Section Certificate** issued by the Tahsildar or Naib Tahsildar on or after 01/04/2023. (Please refer Clause No. 6.7 on page No.10 of the prospectus) Proforma of this certificate is at **Annexure XII** of the Prospectus.
- l) **N.C.C. 'B' or 'C' / Air / Naval /Army wing Certificate** issued by the competent authority.
- m) **No-Objection Certificate'** from the Employer in case of In-service Candidate.

*Note : If any uploaded document is not clearly visible or incomplete then reservation/ claim (whichever is applicable) shall not be given.*

### **C. REJECTION OF APPLICATION FORM**

Application shall not be considered and shall stand rejected automatically on any one or more of the following deficiencies.

- a) If the **Grade Card /Transcript/Course Completion Certificate** of the qualifying examination is not uploaded.
- b) If the **Provisional Degree Certificate or Degree Certificate or Course Completion Certificate** of the qualifying examination is not uploaded.
- c) If **AIEEA-2023 Score Card** not uploaded / not visible.
- d) If the **Leaving Certificate of College or Institute (last attended) Migration Certificate / Bonafide Certificate** is not uploaded/not visible.
- e) If the prescribed **application fees is not paid**.
- f) If candidate **does not fulfill the eligibility** for admission.
- g) The application form of physically handicapped candidates having more than 50% disability shall be rejected.



## 9. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO NRI/FN/PIO/OCI CANDIDATES

- i) Ten seats over and above the existing intake capacity in the faculty of Veterinary Science for M.V.Sc. degree programme are reserved for NRI/FN/PIO/OCI candidates as mentioned in table-1 of clause no. 5 on page no.3. However, not more than one student will be admitted in one discipline in the college.
- ii) Candidate with basic qualification of equivalent degree will have to complete deficiency courses as decided by the Advisor / Advisory Committee.
- iii) The minimum eligibility criteria for admission to M.V.Sc. shall be Bachelor of Veterinary Science with C.G.P.A. not less than 6.00 in 10 point scale i.e. 60% marks.
- iv) The candidates who have passed B.V.Sc. & A.H. or equivalent examination from India must have appeared in **AIEEA-2023**. However, the candidates who have passed B.V.Sc. & A.H. or equivalent examination from abroad shall be exempted from **AIEEA-2023**.
- v) The medium of instruction shall be English only.
- vi) The Non-English speaking candidate seeking admission under NRI/FN/PIO/OCI shall have to clear English language Examination of 100 marks of graduation level from Traditional University of Maharashtra before completion of his degree programme from MAFSU, Nagpur.
- vii) There are no seats for NRI sponsored candidate.
- viii) The NRI/FN/PIO/OCI candidates shall submit the online application form in all respect along with all necessary documents/testimonials.
- ix) The personal presence of the candidate along with all original documents/testimonials on the day of admission/reporting is compulsory, else he/she will not be consider for admission.
  - a) Non Residential Indian (NRI) is an Indian Citizen staying outside India for more than 182 days during year.
  - b) Candidate applying under NRI/Wards of NRI should submit recent NRI status certificate of candidate/parents issued by Indian Embassy/High Commission/Consulate General of the Country concerned with their seal.
  - c) Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) cardholder/person of Indian origin (PIO) should submit necessary proof along with application form.



Before admission the NRI/FN/PIO/OCI candidate will have to apply for appropriate category Indian Visa to the Indian Embassy in their home country. The candidate will have to submit copy of the passport and the visa at the time of admission.

- x) The Director of Instruction & Dean, Faculty of Veterinary Science, MAFSU, Nagpur shall be Nodal Officer for NRI/FN/PIO/OCI admission.
- xi) The candidate shall have to pay special fee equivalent to \$ 12000 (USD) per year in addition to regular fees as per **Annexure VI (C)**.
- xii) Candidates with privilege of Institutional Economic fees e.g. those admitted under Nepal Aid Fund shall have to pay \$ 2000 (USD) per year in addition to regular fees as shown in **Annexure VI (C)**.
- xiii) The selection of the candidate for M.V.Sc. Degree programme will be made on the basis of merit.
- xiv) Online system shall generate the allocation list and allotment letter for the candidate on the University website. The intimation regarding the same shall be sent to the candidates on their registered mobile phone & email address.
- xv) Candidate shall pay the special fee in addition to college fee and if required hostel fees at the time of confirmation of admission at the respective college.
- xvi) The candidate should note that the special fee paid by the candidate for NRI/FN/PIO/OCI quota seat shall not be refunded in any case.
- xvii) Candidate shall be admitted provisionally till he/she registers him/herself in the concerned college where the seat is allotted.
- xviii) Once the candidate secure admission under this category, he/she shall have to pay the fees applicable to NRI/FN/PIO/OCI throughout the course of his studies and no change in Quota will be made.
- xix) For students migrating from Universities outside India, the examinations conducted by such Universities or examining bodies shall be given general equivalence as suggested by equivalence committee after ascertaining the standards of passing & after verifying the course catalogues/syllabus, etc., the deficiency courses, if needed, will have to be completed within a period of one year.

While applying for eligibility certificate, the applicant shall attach with his application, true copies of the following documents along with the originals



## 10. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- i) **The candidates shall read the admission process carefully as stated in the prospectus.**
- ii) The candidate shall apply online, pay the fees, fill up the application form and upload the desired documents on or before last date of submission of application form.
- iii) Before submission of application form, the candidate should ensure that the documents are correctly uploaded and readable. Application form completed in all respect and received online on or before the last date of submission of application form shall only be considered for admission.
- iv) In case any candidate submits more than one application form, the latest filled in application form complete in all respect will only be considered.
- v) Application forms will be primarily scrutinized and the list of candidates with deficient or wrong documents will be displayed on website.
- vi) **Resubmission of deficient documents-** A list of candidates who failed to upload or have wrongly uploaded the desired documents will be displayed on website. These candidates will be required to upload only the indicated documents within the due date specified by the University for resubmission (**Annexure-XIX**).
- vii) Additional documents will not be accepted after due date specified for the purpose of resubmission of deficient documents.
- viii) After final scrutiny, provisional merit list of eligible and list of non-eligible candidate will be displayed on the website (**www.mafsu.ac.in**) as per the scheduled admission programme.
- ix) Candidates aggrieved by the contents of the provisional merit list may prefer an online appeal on or before the last date for submission of grievance as mentioned in admission programme (**Annexure-XIX**) addressed to **The Registrar, MAFSU, Nagpur** in the prescribed online form of grievance application. The candidate shall deposit the grievance application fees **Rs.200/-** (Rupees Two Hundred) in any form as mentioned in the steps earlier. Candidate shall be required to mention the specific reason of grievance.
- x) In case, the documents uploaded by the candidates for constitutional reservation are invalid or rejected by authority, then such candidates if eligible under Unreserved category shall have to pay the difference of application fees (i.e. Rs. 300/-) at the time of submission of grievance for consideration of that candidature under Unreserved category in the final merit list.
- xi) *No additional documents will be accepted along with grievance application form.*
- xii) After receiving the grievance application, the grievance committee will examine the grievances of the candidates on the basis of the documents enclosed along with his/her original online application form.



- xiii) If the applicant fails to appeal on or before last date for submission of grievance, his/her grievance shall not be considered and no further correspondence in this regard shall be entertained.
- xiv) Final merit list of the eligible candidates will be prepared on the basis of score in **AIEEA-2023** and notified on the website by the competent authority. In case of equal marks, the following procedure (Tie-Breaker) shall be adopted for deciding the merit of the candidate.
- First Level** : A candidate with higher corrected points (CGPA / OGPA at B.V.Sc. & A.H. plus applicable weightage) shall be considered, if the tie still persists then,
- Second Level** : A candidate with higher uncorrected CGPA / OGPA at B.V.Sc. & A.H. or degree equivalent thereto shall be considered, if the tie still persists then,
- Third Level** : A candidate with higher percentage of aggregate marks at XII examination shall be considered, if the tie still persists then,
- Fourth Level** : A candidate with higher marks in Biology at XII examination shall be considered, if the tie still persists then,
- Fifth Level** : A candidate with higher marks in Chemistry at XII examination shall be considered, if the tie still persists then,
- Sixth Level** : A candidate with higher aggregate marks at X examination shall be considered.
- xv) For admission to M.V.Sc degree course, 50% seats of the intake capacity ("R" quota) will be filled in from amongst the candidates domicile of Maharashtra and who have passed the qualifying examination from the colleges in respective region as shown in Table No. 2, while remaining 50% seats of the intake capacity ("S" quota) will be available for all the candidates.

- xvi) *Region Quota admission round shall be followed by State Quota round. A candidate belonging to a particular region shall not be entitled for admission to the college from the same region in State Quota round of admission.*
- xvii) *Candidate should note that it is essential for him/her to log in for submission of the option form/preference form for every round of admission. Otherwise he/she shall not be considered for admission during that round.*
- xviii) **First Round of admission** - After receiving the option/preference form, the admission allocation list will be displayed on website (i.e. www.mafsu.ac.in) and the intimation regarding the same shall be sent to the candidates on their mobile phone & email address.

The allotment letter shall be generated for those candidates who have been allotted the seats. The candidate shall personally visit the allotted college along with the printout of allotment letter, all original documents and admission fees to confirm his/her admission within stipulated period of time.

In case, if any candidate does not report to college to confirm the seat during first round then next candidate from the waiting list of the respective category shall be allotted the seats as per merit.

- xix) **Once the seat is allotted as per candidate's first preference for Region/State Quota Round and the candidate does not report to college within the stipulated period of time mentioned in allotment letter, his/her candidature will be cancelled for next rounds of Region/State Quota.**

**Whereas, if the seat is allotted as per candidate's second preference and onwards and the candidate does not report to college, his/her candidature will be considered for next rounds of admission based on vacancies.**

- xx) Candidate shall be admitted provisionally till he / she registers him/herself in the concerned college where the seat is allotted. Once the candidate admitted will not be eligible for admission during subsequent rounds of admission.
- xxi) Candidate, who is admitted but cancel the admission after joining, will not be eligible for admission during subsequent rounds of admission.
- xxii) At the time of admission, during the course of physical verification of the original certificates and documents, if it is noticed that the candidate is not entitled for the weightage(s) which has already been given to him in the final merit list, he / she shall not be entitled for the admission during that round. In such case the Competent Authority may work out the revised merit position of the applicant and will amend the final merit list accordingly and the said applicant shall be considered eligible for admission as per his revised merit in next round of admission.
- xxiii) **Second round of Admission** - The seats remaining vacant after first round of Region / State quota admission will be filled in during the second round of Region / State quota rounds respectively as per the following stepwise





procedure -

- Step I** - Filling of vacant seats separately in reserve and unreserved category as per vacancy position.
- Step II** - Conversion of female seats to male seats separately (if the female candidate of particular category are not available) in reserve / unreserved category.
- Step III** - Conversion of horizontal reservations into respective reserve & unreserved categories.
- Step IV** - Filling of vacant seats in reserve categories (if any) by SBC candidates (Max.2%).
- Step V** - Filling of remaining vacant seats by interse within reserve categories.
- Step VI** - After filling the vacant seats by Step I to Step V if there are any vacancies those will be filled in as per Regional and State merit respectively.
- Note :** After completion of all steps I to VI, the allotment list shall be generated for second round of admission.

In case, if any candidate does not report to college to confirm the seat during second round then next candidate from the waiting list of the respective category shall be allotted the seats as per merit.

- xxiv) **Third Round of admission** - The seats remaining vacant after second round of Regional as well as State quota admission (**Annexure-IV & V**) will be combined and filled in during the third round.
- xxv) **Special Round of admission** - The seats remaining vacant after third round of admission will be filled in during the special admission round by irrespective of group. The seats will be filled in by candidate as per merit from that respective reservation category.
- xxvi) **Annexure XIII, XIV, XV XVI and XVII** shall have to be submitted by candidate to the Associate Dean of concerned college where he/she has been admitted.
- xxvii) The student who secures admission for the degree course shall have to submit proof of his Aadhar Card, Bank Account details and Voter Card to the office of the Associate Dean of the respective college.
- xxviii) The admissions to various seats under Regional (R) and State (S) Quota shall be final and once the candidate is admitted he/she will not be eligible for change of College or Quota.
- xxix) The candidate admitted under this University shall abide by rules and regulation of this University and changes made therein from time to time.
- xxx) Any candidate if found obstructing the admission process, trying to influence in unlawful manner and / or creating nuisance shall be liable for disqualification from the admission process. The decision taken by the Competent Authority in this respect shall be final and binding.
- xxxi) All the admissions shall be deemed as provisional and subject to further scrutiny



and verification, if required. Admission shall be liable for cancellation at any stage during the course study of the student, if it is found that the admission was contrary to the rules or invalid by reason of incorrect or false information furnished by the applicant or parents/guardians at the time of admission. Any such cancellation of admission may lead to penal action.

- xxxii) Any issue not mentioned in prospectus shall be decided by the Competent Authority of the admission, which shall be final and binding.
- xxxiii) The candidates are required to visit and see the information and updates on MAFSU website/admission portal (www.mafsu.ac.in). The candidates whose applications are rejected for some or other reasons shall not be individually communicated.

### 11. CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION:

- i. If a student desires to cancel his / her admission for a bonafide reason, he /she will have to apply to the concerned Associate Dean of the College.
- ii. After receiving duly signed admission cancellation request letter from the candidate, the Associate Dean of the college shall cancel the admission immediately and inform the university regarding vacancy generated due to cancellation.
- iii. If a student cancels his / her admission and applies to the Associate Dean of the College is eligible to get refund of fees as per given below-

5	00%	More than 30 days <b>after</b> formally-notified last date of admission

- Note-** a) In case of (1) mentioned in above table, the concern college shall deduct an amount not more than 5% of the fees paid by the student subject to a maximum of Rs.5000/- as processing charges from the refundable amount.  
b) In case of (5) mentioned in above table, only the caution money shall be refunded to the student.

However, no refund except caution money will be admissible after cancellation of admission any time during the degree course or completion of degree course.

- iv. If candidate is admitted under NRI/FN/PIO/OCI quota, special fees deposited by such candidate shall not be refunded in any case.



## PART - II

### 1. COURSE DURATION

The total course duration would be of 2 academic years i.e. four consecutive semesters. Medium of instructions & examination shall be in English.

### 2. REGISTRATION

- i) After receipt of admission letter, candidate will have to report to the concerned Associate Dean for registration of First semester of M.V.Sc.
- ii) Registration of the students will be in consultation with the counselors.
- iii) Submission of registration forms in the Academic cell duly filled in and signed by the student, counselor and course teacher within prescribed time failing which the admission shall be cancelled.
- iv) Fees shall be deposited in the office of the Associate Dean of the college.
- v) The candidate has to register for each semester in person. In absentia registration shall not be allowed in any case.

### 3. ATTENDANCE

If a student fails to attend minimum seventy-five percent of the total number of scheduled lectures and practical separately in a laboratory / field / assignment, classes in a course held during a semester, he/she shall not be eligible to appear at the semester-end examination and shall be declared as failed. Such a student shall repeat the course(s) when offered.

### 4. HOSTEL ACCOMODATION

Hostel accommodation for a limited number of students is available at the constituent colleges of the University. Every student admitted to constituent colleges may not necessarily be given hostel accommodation. Hostel facility at PGIVAS, Akola is provided for girls only.

### 5. DISCIPLINE

1. The cases of unfair means and the cases of misbehavior will be dealt with as per the rules and regulations of the University in vogue and as amended from time to time.
2. Students while studying in the colleges if allegedly found involved in activities like ragging, bullying or kidnapping and any other act of indiscipline shall immediately be suspended from the college as well as the hostel without any notice by the Associate Dean of the College and are liable to be expelled from the college by the Vice-Chancellor on the detailed report of the Registrar of the University.



3. As per the provision of Maharashtra Act XXXIII known as “Maharashtra Prohibition of ragging Act of 1999”, students indulged in ragging can be punished under the Act resulting in suspension, expulsion from the college and imprisonment.
4. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student will be given liberty to explain and if explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him from the institution.

## 6. IMPORTANT ACADEMIC REGULATIONS

### (1) Transfer of student within University:-

Transfer of student within the University will not be permitted in any case.

### (2) Requirement for completion of degree:-

The minimum residential requirement for completion of Master’s degree shall be four consecutive semesters from the date of admission. The Candidate admitted for the Master's degree may be declared qualified for the degree provided the candidate completes all the prescribed requirements maximum within 8 consecutive semesters from the date of admission to the Master's Degree programme, provided he/she registers for each semester regularly. If he/she fails to register for any of the semester, his/her admission shall be cancelled.

### (3) Change in subject:-

The student once admitted to a particular college he/she can change the subject as per the availability of seats after last round of admission (i.e. after completion of admission process) within same college only. Such seats will be notified by the Registrar within seven days after last round of admission. Student shall have to apply for a change in subject through their Associate Dean to the Registrar within next seven days after the last date of vacancy notification. Applications of the students shall be considered strictly on the basis of merit and availability of vacant seats. The student desirous to change subject in the college, can apply for change the subject within the group of under which he/she sought admission in that particular college. No application shall be entertained after the above-specified period. These facilities shall be applicable only to students admitted up to the last round of admission. This clause shall not be applicable to the candidates admitted through ICAR quota

### (4) Break in Study:-

Student shall be permitted to break his/her studies subject to following conditions -

- Candidate shall be allowed to take break in studies only after successful completion of courses of first two semesters registered by him/her. This condition shall not be applicable to female candidate availing maternity leave.



- The candidate shall have to apply for break in studies on valid reasons to the Registrar with the recommendation of the concerned Sectional Head and Dean/Associate Dean of the concerned college/institute.
- Candidate shall be allowed a maximum break of five semester once only during his/her Master's Degree Course. However, female candidate shall be allowed a break for one semester on recommendation of registered medical practitioner during advanced pregnancy at any time of study. This special concession shall be given once during her course curriculum subject to having less than two children. Moreover, the student has to complete the degree programme in maximum period as prescribed in the regulation for completion of Master's Degree and if the course curriculum is in vogue at that time.
- Candidate has to pay gap fees (equivalent to Registration Fees) of all the semesters at the time of registration after the break for which he/she could not register in order to continue his/her registration.
- Candidate shall have to complete all the prescribed requirements of Master's Degree course within 10 consecutive semesters from the date of admission.
- For re-admission, candidate shall have to apply to the Registrar through Associate Dean of the college.
- The absence other than mentioned above will be dealt as per Academic Regulation No. EC146/2022.

**(5) Removal of name from roll:-**

The name of the student may be removed by the Registrar from the roll of the University duly recommended by the Associate Dean for any one or more of the following reasons in addition to Maintenance and Discipline regulation and Good Conduct Rules - 2001 for the students passed by the Executive Council vide Resolution No. 32/2001 of dated 17/08/2001.

- a) Non-payment of penalties/dues on or within the dates fixed for the purpose.
- b) Continuous absence for a period of fifteen days or more in classes without permission.
- c) Misbehavior of any kind including disrespectful conduct and acts of violence causing willful damage to the University property, participation in strikes, demonstrations or disturbances of any kind, behaving in such a manner as to bring the University or his/her teacher into disrepute.
- d) Violation of any of the University/College/Hostel Rules.
- e) Negligence in studies.
- f) Non-registration of any of the semester or unable to complete all the prescribed requirement within prescribed semesters

The discipline amongst students shall be maintained as per the provisions under section 56 of the MAFSU Act XVII of 1998.

**(6) Medical examination:** Medical examination is compulsory for all the students and the same should be done from the Civil Surgeon/University Medical Officer or other Medical Officer as nominated by the College/Institute and approved by the University within a period of two months from the date of admission. Date of medical examination shall be fixed by Dean/Associate Dean after last round of admission.

Certificate of sports/debate essay/elocution competition/youth festival issued by the appropriate authority (District Sports Officer / Sports Council / Deputy Director / Education Officer of Zilla Parishad / Director of Student Welfare / Student Welfare Officer) stating that applicant has represented in inter-University tournament / competition should be enclosed. Certificate should be preferably in the format as per **Annexure-XI** of the prospectus.

**[3] Certificate of N.S.S. Camp**

If the candidate was member of NSS during his B.V.Sc. & A.H. studies in such case the candidate must enclose the certificate issued by the competent authority of the constituent college/University for claiming the benefit of weightage.

**[4] Publication of research paper**

If the candidate has published research paper/s during his B.V.Sc. & A.H. studies and thereafter, in scientific journal which is abstracted nationally & internationally. The candidate has to enclose reprint of the research paper for claiming the benefit of weightage. (Weightage shall not be considered for abstracts, paper presentation in conference, Public extension articles in daily newspapers, etc.)

**[5] Certificate of parents being employee of MAFSU**

If father/mother of the candidate is/was an employee of MAFSU, Nagpur or its constituent colleges or research station or farms the claim of additional weightage will be considered, provided he / she has enclosed certificate in this behalf issued by Head of the Office / Controlling officer / Competent Authority.
